

EDUCATOR ANSWER KEY – DAILY TASKS RISK CHART

The language used (common, possible, not common, not possible) mimics the language to describe STBBI transmission risk (i.e., commonly passed and not commonly passed). The key provides a translation for how this language is related to possible consequences and risk in activities that we do everyday. Support students in making the connection between likelihood of consequences related to different daily activities and likelihood of passing on different STBBIs.

Common = There is usually a consequence

Possible = There could be a consequence in the right conditions

Not common = Consequences are unlikely but there may be a chance

Not possible = There is no possibility of a consequence
